



DRAUGHTSPERSON NQF 5

A Draughtsperson is the person who works in conjunction with an Engineer or Architect to create and conceptualize drawings using specific computer drawing software, for structural steel, buildings, mechanical or other detailed technical plans or drawings.

Graduates will work in designing and preparing computer generated technical drawings and 3D visuals for architects, engineers and manufacturers, and will qualify them for jobs such as a Piping Draughtsperson, Computer Aided Designer or AutoCAD Draughtsperson.*
